The Joseph and Sandra Ferro Scholarship was established in June 2003 in appreciation and gratitude for what the Church has meant to us through the years. The recipient shall be a graduating senior at Tolland High or a member (or child of a member) of the United Congregational Church who meets the following criteria:

- *He or she shall be in the top 20% of the High School graduating class.*
- *The recipient shall have a demonstrated financial need. A copy of the FAFSA determination letter shall be included with this application.*
- *He/she must plan to enroll at and maintain full-time enrollment in a four year residential college within the CT State University System or the University of Connecticut, majoring in Education. Please attach a copy of your Letter of Acceptance. (A non-Education major may be selected if no suitable candidate(s) meet the primary criteria.)*

The scholarship award will be \$1,000, renewable in the sophomore, junior, and senior years, given in January upon receipt of proof of enrollment for the second semester. A 3.0 C.P.A. is required. If a recipient's C.P.A. should fall below 3.0 in a given year, re-attainment of a 3.0 shall merit the receipt of the award for the subsequent year.

Acceptance of the award includes responsibility for writing a brief narrative each January outlining his/her educational accomplishments and future goals, as well as the "recipient covenant" as printed at the end of the application form.
