Established in June, 2021, the Susan K. Errickson Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior from high school who demonstrates those characteristics that Sue's family and friends loved and admired in her. Sue's love of history, curiosity for religion, ability to bring out the potential in the individual, and dedication to community was exhibited in her actions and approach to life. An active member in the Tolland Historical Society and the UCCT, Sue also served on the Tolland Planning and Zoning Committee for more than 30 years. Sue valued her Tolland community and friendships -- relationships grounded in faith, civic duty, generosity and support.

The recipient of the Susan K. Errickson Scholarship shall be a graduating senior from Tolland High School. Preference will be given to a UCCT member or a child of a UCCT member or a student from a marginalized population.

The successful recipient shall:

- have a desire to study the Humanities, Education, or a related field, with a demonstrated willingness to give back to their community through civic engagement and service.
- be in the top 50% of their high school graduating class.
- plan to attend and maintain full-time enrollment in a two or four-year college/university. Please attach a copy of your Letter of Acceptance.

The scholarship award will be \$1,000.
